

AMLO – Daily press conference coverage

December 11, 2018

- **The President said that the 2019 Budget will be delivered to Congress on Saturday (legal deadline to turn it in) by the Minister of Finance, Carlos Urzúa**
- **On the energy reform, he stated that according to his team’s assessment, the 3-year grace period to evaluate contracts awarded to private companies in the oil sector is reasonable to observe results. This was in response to a reporter’s question that some specialists have raised their concerns that this time frame is way too short**
- **He reaffirmed the commitment of not intervening in the internal affairs of unions, including that none of them be associated with the government. Moreover, he reminded that the latter was agreed in the new trade agreement with the US and Canada (USMCA)**
- **AMLO is not planning any international trips for now, focusing his efforts on implementing the changes offered throughout his campaign. Today, he will go to Jojutla, in the State of Morelos, to present the plan to support victims of last year’s earthquakes**
- **The government is working with the US on immigration, affirming that he has already presented a document proposing an investment treaty in which other Central American countries would also take part**
- **Lastly, cabinet members detailed the program to support migrants on their trips to Mexico during the holiday season, with coordinated actions in entry points and municipalities including security reinforcements, support in transit on highways and customs, among others**

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
