

AMLO – Daily press conference coverage

December 4, 2018

- **Today, the second daily press conference of President Andres Manuel López-Obrador took place**
- **Comments were centered around public security, the New Mexico City Airport, wages for public servants, and the Education Reform**
- **He affirmed that no information system with daily updates of delinquencies is currently available but that it will be ready next week, particularly for those cases in which data is more trustworthy, such as homicides and vehicle theft**
- **Moreover, he announced that the first initiative to reform Article 108 of the Constitution to eliminate the presidential immunity will be sent today**
- **About the New Mexico City Airport (NAICM), he informed that public servants from the Ministry of Finance will provide further details about the buyback proposal today, reaffirming that his government favors free markets when considering economic decisions**
- **In this respect, he argued that yesterday's market's response was positive, with gains in the stock market and no depreciation in the Mexican peso**
- **Commenting on wages for public servants, he reaffirmed that authorities will resolve any controversies that arise regarding the downward adjustment in wages, and that the argument that this reduction could foster higher corruption is “not serious”**
- **Last but not least, he stated that the project for the cancellation of the Education Reform will likely be presented next week, as it is practically ready and in which teachers participated**

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
