This week we have no relevant economic releases

Weekly international reserves report. Last week, net international reserves decreased by US\$128 million, closing at US\$178.7 billion. According to Banxico's report, this figure comes mainly from a negative valuation effect in central bank assets. In this context, the central bank's international reserves have increased US\$3.9 billion during 2019 (please refer to the following table).

Weekly government bond auction. The Ministry of Finance (MoF) –via Banco de Mexico as its financial agent, will offer 30-year fixed-rate Mbonos (Nov'47), 30-year inflation-linked Udibonos (Nov'46), 5-year Bondes D, in addition to the 1-, 3-, 6-, and 12-month zero-coupon Cetes (see following table). As usual, results will be released at 12:30pm (ET).
