Flash: Domestic passengers resume growth in March

Volaris disclosed that total passengers in March decreased by only 1.2% y/y, but showed solid sequential growth of 35.6% m/m – carrying a total of 1.5 million–. Highlights included a 3.5% y/y rise on the domestic side, due to improved demand. On the international side, passengers continued to be weak, showing a 23.3% y/y decline due to US restrictions on international flights. In this regard, capacity measured in terms of Available Seat Miles (ASMs) fell 7.2% y/y. It is worth noting that capacity in 1Q21 was 88.3% vs. the same period of the previous year, higher than the 85% previously announced by the airline. On the other hand, demand measured in Revenue Passenger Miles (RPMs) fell to a lesser extent with -2.0% y/y. This resulted in a 4.6pp year-over-year increase in the load factor to 86.9%.

Positive implication: We believe that March's traffic report should be welcomed by the market and, in turn, reaffirms our expectation that the following month will see an inflection point in Volaris' total passengers. On this occasion, the domestic side has already shown positive variations. Going forward, we expect demand performance to continue to improve, which goes hand in hand with the company's announcement to operate at 110% of capacity in 2Q21 compared to 2Q19. This underpins our 2021 growth outlook for Volaris, which we could be confirming after the 1Q21 report.
